

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
March 26, 2026**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Senator Cris Dush invited the Township to an “Introduction to Funding Opportunities” on April 28th & 29th.

DEP notification was received stating Noble Environmental has withdrawn their permit application for the Brockway Transload Facility.

PennDot sent notification of an upcoming resurfacing & milling project on RT 28.

The Jefferson Co. Office of County Commissioners sent a copy of their opposition letter to the Surface Transportation Board regarding the Notice of Exemption filed by Lampwrights, LLC.

A request was received to file a response to the Notice of Exemption filed by Lampwrights, LLC to construct a rail-to-truck waste transfer station.

The minutes from the February Meeting were approved as read.

The March Treasurer’s Report was read with balances as of March 28, 2026. General Fund balance \$504,398.49; Liquid Fuels Fund balance \$167,584.74.
