

**Snyder Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
June 25, 2026**

The monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Holt in the Snyder Township Building, 15706 Route 28, Brockway, Pennsylvania at 7:00 PM. Chairman Holt welcomed everyone and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisors present were Michael Holt, Ronald Freemer, and Jeremy Bassetti. Township Officials present were Secretary-Treasurer Sarah Anderson, Roadmaster, Joe Puhala, Auditor, Jake Rindosh, Code Officer, Jeff Knapp, EMA Coordinator Terry Fustine, Deputy EMA Coordinator, Sam Marrara, and Water Authority Rep. Michael Holt motioned to accept the lowest responsible bidder, Chris Hostetler, at \$314,900.00 for the new garage construction, with Jeremy Bassetti second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried. The Board will request a signed contract with an agreed upon payment schedule.

NEW BUSINESS:

Michael Holt motioned to obtain financing quotes from local banks for July's meeting with Jeremy Bassetti second. All supervisors voted yes and the motion carried.

Michael Holt mentioned the Kaimans plan to purchase "Welcome to Brockway" signs in 2027. They would like to put one in the township yard.
